






Step 3 Click the E-mail Accounts button.

Under the E-mail tab, click the New button to add your e-mail account.




Step 4:Select manually configure server settings or additional server types and then click the **Next** button.

Select the **IMAP** type of account and then click the **Next** button.




- Enter **Your Name**. This is the name that will appear when others receive your e-mail.




